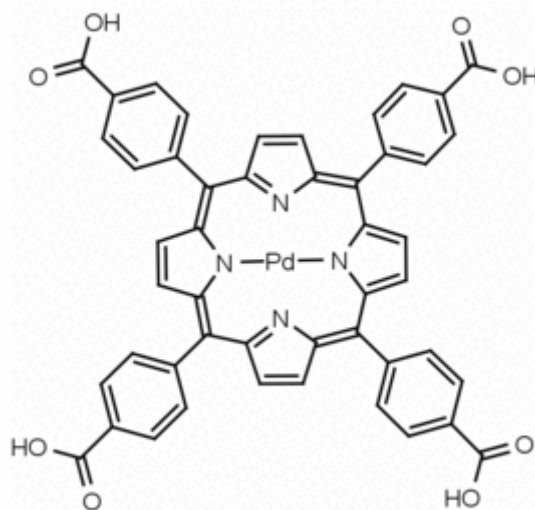

**Background: Pd(II) meso-Tetra(4-carboxyphenyl)porphine** is a porphyrin based synthetic product and fine chemical used in the generation of metal organic frameworks and dendritic frameworks. <sup>1,2</sup> These frameworks can be used for oxygen detection and for catalytic modification of organic molecules by hydrogenation reactions. <sup>3,4</sup>
